

ALCOHOL SERVICE POLICY

TOYOTA CENTER

It is OUR policy that ALL Guests wear a wristband to consume alcoholic beverages at the Toyota Center.

Wristbands can be obtained at a concession stand OR at wristband location on the concourse.

To receive a wristband you must provide a valid ID.

I.D.'s ALLOWED – all allowable forms of I.D must not be expired, must picture the individual it represents and must be readable in English. These would include:

- A drivers license issued by any U.S. state or Canadian province
- An identification card issued by any U.S. state or Canadian province
- A Washington State temporary drivers license accompanied by an otherwise valid, punched drivers license
- Government issued Passport
- Valid, Military I.D.
- Guests in possession of or observed consuming alcoholic beverages that are under the age of 21 will be referred to the Kennewick Police Department in all circumstances for appropriate citation or arrest.
- At any time, Campus Management reserves the right to suspend or completely discontinue the sale or service of alcoholic beverages at any event.
- No more than two alcoholic beverages may be provided to a guest at anytime. For some events, this limit may be one. Some events, such as family shows, high school events or religious events we may choose not to sell any alcohol.
- If a guest is observed passing an alcoholic beverage to someone who does not possess a wristband, this beverage will be removed. NO REFUNDS. Depending on the transaction this could also include eviction or possibly referred to the Kennewick Police Department.
- Management can remove a patron's wristband, at its discretion, for any reason.
- Alcohol service will cease at least one hour prior to the end of an event.
